

Golf Cart Rules 2023

Safety is everyone's responsibility

Golf Cart Owners must agree to operate their vehicles in a safe manner and adhere to all rules set forth by Shady Pines Campgrounds.

- SPC Golf Cart Registration is required each year. Show proof of insurance, sign the general liability waiver, and pay the charging fee (\$175 + HST) to get your registration sticker. <u>Registration stickers must be displayed on golf carts BEFORE</u> being permitted to drive on the campgrounds.
- 2. All golf carts are **REQUIRED** to **clearly display**:
 - a. Current SPC registration sticker on the driver's side of the cart
 - b. Owner's site numbers not less than 3"/8cm in height on both sides of the cart
- 3. Only electric golf carts are permitted.
- 4. Golf cart speed is **10 km/hr** everywhere on the grounds.
- 5. All drivers must be at least 16 years of age.
- 6. Maximum number of people permitted on a golf cart:
 - a. With two bench seats 4 adults or 2 adults & 3 children.
 - b. With one bench seat 2 adults or 1 adult & 2 children.
- 7. All riders must remain seated while the golf cart is in motion.
- 8. Do not drive while impaired. No open alcohol or recreational drugs on the carts.
- 9. Headlights and taillights are required after dark. No homemade lighting.
- 10. After 11 p.m. golf carts are not permitted to be driven around the campground.
- 11.Golf carts operated in a manner that may endanger passengers or pedestrians will not be tolerated, ie: speeding, reckless driving, or overloading (see item 6 for capacity).
- 12. Owners of the golf cart are responsible for the actions and activity of any person driving or riding on their cart; and will be held liable if misuse, damage to property, or personal injury should occur.

GOLF CARTS ARE A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT!
